- 2. Help to train specialists with good understanding and skills in the field of environmental sustainability

- 4. Improve the cooperation between the universities and strengthen their social impact by creating inter-institutional


Green Deal Centre for Evidence-based Education, Research, Innovation and Public Outreach (GDCentre)
