

KOICA Scholarship

According to the letter of the Ministry of Investment and Foreign Trade of the Republic of Uzbekistan (aprel05-45-03825 dated April 26, 2022 and the Korean International Cooperation Agency (KOICA), in the 2022 academic year, Korean universities admission) and doctoral scholarship competitions have been announced. Candidates must have 2 years of work experience and meet certain requirements, including teachers and researchers of higher educational institutions of the republic.
